SPECTATORS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches or officials/umpires.
- If you disagree with an official/umpire, raise the issue through the team's officials rather than question the official/umpire in public.
- If you consider your child is being treated unfairly by a coach or official/umpire, discuss the matter in a non-confrontational manner after the game to avoid embarrassing your child and yourself.
- Respect officials/umpires decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials/umpires etc. Without them there would be no team and your child could not participate.
- Do not coach from the sideline. The coach is responsible for coaching and the parents are to encourage the team.
- Ensure your child does not play with an injury.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form be it by parents, spectators, coaches, officials/umpires or players.
